Foundation and Advanced Training in Bristol in Homeopathic Medicine for veterinary healthcare professionals

Training is practice and case based with a focus on observation. These skills are used to gain a greater understanding of the complexity of disease, to learn how to match homeopathic medicines to the pattern of symptoms and increase the therapeutic options for treating acute and chronic disease.

Foundation is one year. The course is modular over 4 years, 5 module teaching days a year, linked by coursework, and 2 days of clinical teaching to fit around a busy vets practice.

Teaching is by vets and medical professionals experienced in homeopathic medicine. Assessment is by coursework, a portfolio of casework, and exams to LFHom Vet and MFHom Vet qualifications accredited by the Faculty of Homeopathy.
